

Emergency call

Eleven makers were selected for Graft Emergency 2016, the biennial open submission exhibition running until 22 January 2017 at Aspex in Portsmouth. Included in this year's show are Jacky Puzey, Helen Snell and Ben Branagan, with this year's prize of a solo presentation at the gallery in 2018 and a fee of £1,000 going to ceramist Tessa Eastman. She impressed the judges with her colourful, glazed ceramic sculptures, which draw inspiration from organic forms seen through the lens of a microscope. Winners in previous years include two past cover stars of Crafts letter-carver and stonemason Thomas Appleton and ceramist Malene Hartmann Rasmussen.
